on the west side Sudbury River: And lyeth on both sides the mill brook
And between the meadow of Josiah Haydon: and the heirs of John Brigham
late of Sudbury Deceased. And is Bounded Easterly on to Haydens meadow
and on the Land of Capt Joshua Hayns: Bounded westerly on the Land
and meadow of the heirs of John Brigham a bound Bounded southerly and
Northerly by marked trees. And stakes: as signified in the plat: with a
high way through the same as prickd out in the plat: This four Acres
of Swamp and upland was laid out in full satisfaction for a high way layd
out Crosse said moors Land and meadow: Crosse the said brook through his
Horns Head: off Hope brook: Surveyed by me David Hayns

The subscribers laid out a high way from the Contry Road by Mr Heards to
Zobediah Allons: and into the high way: laid out a Crosse pine plain by said
Allons: beginning said high way: at a stake standings in Elisha Rices fence:
marked on the southerly side of the high way: the high way is laid out: three
Rods wide: on the north: of said stake: and marked pine trees: between said
marked trees and Land of James Graues: and so a stake marked standing in
Joseph Goodnows fence on the south side of said way: and a pine tree marked
at the East End of Edward Grouts Ditch: and so on between Edward Grouts
Ditch and Land of John Groat: And so turning by Edward Grouts Ditch
between the Land of Edward Groat and Land of Jonathan Groat so on all
the way from where we began: three Rods wide till it comes to the southerly
End of Edward Grouts Draw bars: And from said Draw bars: five Rods wide
on the westerly side of Edward Grouts Ditch: till it comes to the foot of the hill
and then two Rods wide a Crosse a valley to Joseph Goodnows Land a strait
line from the south west Corner of Edward Grouts Land to a stake marked in
Joseph Goodnows fence on the East side of said way: and is laid out: three Rods
wide on the west side of said Goodnows Land: to a post marked in said Goodnows
fence: and so on by said Goodnows fence: to the Contry Road: And from the said
post in said Joseph Goodnows fence turning westward including the Cart
path going from said Goodnows fence to Mr Heards Dwelling House till
it comes into the Contry Road:

south side of the way and so on between the Land of Jonathan Groat: and Land of
John Groat: three Rods wide: to the turning of the way: including the Cart path
bounded by marked trees: on the south side: and turning westerly to whals
bridge: Bounded westerly by marked trees and including the Cart path: all the
way to the brook: at whals bridge: and on the north side of the brook: bounded
by marked trees on the East side of the way: and the New standing fence of
Benjamin parmenter and so including all the Land not yet laid out till it comes into
the Contry Road by Amos Sanderson: and Benjamin parmenters
