

And the subscribers select men of the town of Sudbury have laid out a way in and
 for the Common and publick use of sd town and on the westerly side of Sudbury River
 beginning at Lancaster Road and att the bottom or Easterly End of the land lying
 between the Orchard land of Mr. Peter Haynes and the land of Peter Plymton
 now in the occupation of Sam^l Eaton: and from thence Northerly: Running between
 the land of sd Peter Haynes: as the Cart path now is to the Brook Called Lakes End
 Brook and from thence more Nor Easterly: South Easterly bounded by land laid out
 to the Right of John Freeman: and till it Comes almost to a place Called
 Johns Dart and from thence Running on Still as the Cart path now is between the
 Land of John Haynes Nor Easterly having the marks of sd way on the Nor Easterly
 side until sd way Comes out a flow Called Logg flow: then turning more
 Northerly by the land of the sd John Haynes: a little way the marks Come on the
 westerly side then turning an angle westerly Running as the Cart path now is
 for the most part: having the land of the sd John Haynes: and Josiah Haynes and
 the marks of sd way on the South East side: untill said way to land Called Indian
 fort: and so on westerly: as the Cart path now is: having the land of Joseph
 Muzzey: and the land of Uriah Wheller and the marks of sd way on the southerly
 side: to the land of Capt David Haynes: and so on through sd Capt Haynes land: Trees
 being marked on the southerly side until sd way Comes almost to a hill Called
 Walnut Kill: and then through the land of Uriah Wheller: to pantree Road
 and then turning southerly into sd pantree Road
 by the house of sd Uriah Wheller: until we Come unto a small oak marked
 where we turned out by sd pantree Road southerly as the now most Convenient
 Cart path is for travelling to a bridge Called New Bridge: having the marks of sd
 way on the Easterly side: and from sd bridge up a Granully Hill: and so on through
 lands laid out for a Framing field: and so on southerly through or between the lands
 of the sd John Haynes: as the Cart path now is: over a Hill Called Virgin Hill
 having the marks of sd way on the Northerly side: and Easterly through or between
 the lands of the sd Capt David Haynes: to the Top of an hill Called Lakes End: Hill: as
 the Cart path now is: and from thence southeasterly: Running including all the
 Cart paths: leading down said Lakes End hill: and all the land lying between
 sd paths: untill sd way Comes unto the afore sd Lakes End Brook: Note the above
 said way is laid out three Rods wide from End to End: Except where it lyes
 through the land of the sd Capt David Haynes: lying on the Northerly side of pine
 meadow: and there it is four Rods wide: and where sd way Comes into the above sd
 pantree Road: is about two Rods wide: and Close the backward way is
 marked untill it Comes to three Rods wide: and likewise at sd Lakes End hill: to lye
 and be as before described: like wise we the subscribers select men have laid out another
 way of three Rods wide for particular: beginning att a great oak tree marked: being
 the corner mark between the meadow of Peter Plymton: and the meadow of Martha
 Griffon: Called pine meadow: and on the Northerly side of sd way on the South westerly side
 untill sd way Comes into the above sd way at a pine tree marked: all which is submitted
 unto the sd town for their Exeptions and Confirmation Joshua Haynes?
