At a select mens meeting the select men discontinued the way
leading from the house of Capt Thomas Brintnott late of Sudbury deceased
leading to John Goodnow And laid out a way near there Beginning Nigh the
place where Jo Capt Brintnott shop stood and so along by the west side of
a white Oak Tree through into the Country Road The way to be the
same width as the other which we have discontinued two Rods wide

At a select mens meeting: all the request of paul brintnol the
select men discontinued: a way leading from Lanharn to the Clay pits
on the East side to paul brintnol Burn: And opened an other way through
said paul brintnol Land: beginning att the brow of the hill: leaving two
Rods upon the North East side of the stakes set up: by the select mens order
leading into the Country Road: the way to be as wide as the Land is left
the said paul brintnol: proposed to Give the Land in Exchange for the
Old way formerly laid out from where the New way begin to where it Ends

all the Desire and request of Benjamin permonter Junr of Sudbury: we the select men for the town of Sudbury have laid out and staked a two Road high way leading from malbrough Road Near Sandy hill on the west side of Sudbury River to a white oak tree: it being the Corner mark of the Land formerly in the possession of Jonathan Grant Late of Sudbury Decesd: and as the proprietors of said Sudbury Left the Land for a High way the white oak tree being on the East side of the said High way

Judbury march 11 1835

all the town meeting loagaly returned
to town by a vote accepted of this Return
and ordered the same to be Recorded
