

Upon the Define and at the Request of Jundry of the Inhabitants of the town
of Sudbury and for the Commonwey and accomodation of the town use the select men of
the said town of Sudbury have laid out a by or town way lying and being in Sudbury
above and on the westerly side of the Sudbury River beginning at the Road called
malbrough Road between the land of Mr Abraham Woods and the land of Thomas Briggs
and from thence Northerly running as the Cart path now goes between the land
of the Woods and Briggs And so on by and between the land of Josiah Richardson
and so on between and by the land of Noah Clap till said way comes to a small
Gutter: The marks of said way so far are all on the westerly side Then turning
something more Easterly taking the Right hand Road over an other Gutter and so on
over a plain called Stony plain by the land of Edward Joyner and so on between the
land of Joseph Muzzey then turning something more Easterly between the land
of Capt David Haynes and so on between the meeting house and school house and
by the Norwest and Northerly sides of the Burying place leaving Hop Hill Brownes Esq
Tomb about four or five feet to the Southward of the way and so on Eastwardly as
the trees are marked into the Cart path again and so on over a Brook called
the Trees are marked into the Cart path again and so on over a Brook called
mine way then turning more Eastwardly taking the Right hand Cart
way over a hill called mine way or pondoltons hill till said way comes into the
high way leading by Peter Plymtons and so along in said high way till it comes to
a white oak tree marked standing against Jonathan Puffer's Land: then turning
Northeastwardly through the said Puffer Land within his field fence till said way
comes near to or against his Dwelling House: Then going out of said field as the
trees are marked untill said way comes to the bottom of an hill then turning
and more Northly running as the Cart path now goes untill it comes to the Land of
John Haynes Note the said way is three Rods wide all a long: Excepting as
followeth viz Between the Land of the afored Woods and Briggs to be as wide
as the Lane now is: and between the Lands of the afored Joseph Muzzey and
Capt Haynes to be two Rods wide and where said way goes over afored pondolton
hill to be as wide as the marks of said way now stands on each side Taking off some
few Rods of the widow Susanah Clantons Land into said way lying on the
Easterly side of said Hill and when the way goes through the Land of the said
Jonathan Puffer to be two Rods wide the marks of the way from the afored
Gutter are on the Easterly and Southwardly side to the end all which is submitted to
the said town for their acceptance and Confirmation
