The select men laid out a way beginning at a Rock near Peter Voyes barn running Norwestly by marked Trees on the Easterly side going two Rods wide it runs to the New Grant High way then running in the New Grant High way to Rods wide by marked Trees to land of Jam^s Willis son then running Northly through the Land of Jam^s Willis son Two Rods wide by marked Trees as the path now is by marked Trees on the Easterly side to the Land of Joseph Balcom son then through Land Joseph Balcom two Rods wide by marked Trees on the East side To the Land of John Balcom then running through the Land of John Balcom Two Rods wide Northly by marked Trees on the Easterly side to the Land of Joseph Balcom then running through the Land of Joseph Balcom two Rods wide Easterly by marked Trees passing a Rock on the westerly side To through the Land of Joseph Balcom two Rods wide by marked trees on the westerly side

And the subscribers select men of Judbury have laid out a highway on the Easterly side of the River in Judbury beginning at the Road leading to Concord at a place called or known by the name of whals bridge for to be four Rods on the westerly side of said bridge or brook and two Rods on each side of the other Road unto the D^d Brook so a Cross to Brook leading to the pine plain and from D^d Brook to a white oak tree marked near the top of the Hill so to a white oak stump on the still and from thence to a pine marked and from thence to an other pine marked and from thence to an other pine marked and from thence to the Road going by Elisha Rices to wester which marks is the North North Easterly side of the Road which Road is to be two Rods wide from the Easterly side of D^d bridge or brook till it striketh the Old Road to Elisha Rices
