Written and Laid out a Road ^{from Ebenezer} as follows We Beginning
In Mr Saml Dakins Land at a Stake on y^e East Side of Do.

fence and so By said fence To a Stake Near Mr Saml
Dakins House Then by y^e Bound are on y^e West Side of Do.
Road th^e Being two Rods wide To an Elm and from thence
By Do Dakins fence To his Corner Then Do Way Runs through

at a Heap of Stones on y^e East Side of said Road to a
Small Oak and from thence to another Oak & to a Black
