

Feb: 4. 15. 1731/8

The Selectmen of Andbury laid out a Way or Road on y^e West Side of Little Gulph To Pantrey Bridge & its Boundaries as followeth viz. Easterly By little Gulph meadow till it Coms to the Lower End of Little Gulph and then Southerly By the fence till it Coms over the fence By m^rs Zachariah Maynards to a Dry Pine & from thence to a Small White oak Near To Pantrey Bridge.

The marks on the Westerly & Northerly Side of the way are as followeth viz Beginning at y^e upper End of Little Gulph

1. a Small Pine tree 2 Ditto 3. a larger Pine 4 a Small pine
5. Ditto 6. a White Oak 7. Ditto 8. a White Oak at the lower End of Little Gulph 9 a large Dry Pine 10. a Small pine
- 11 Ditto 12. a White oak 13 a Stake at Zach. Maynards Land 14 a White oak 15. a pine 16. Ditto 17. a White oak 18. a Bush
19. Ditto 20 a White oak 21. a pine 22. a Swamp oak 23 a Pine 24 a White oak 25. a Gray oak 26. a maple
- 27 a Gray Oak 28. a White oak 29 a gray oak 30 a Pine 31 a White Oak In m^rs David Maynards fence
- 32 a pine 33. a gray Oak 34. as the fence ^{Runs} to a Stake. In the fence a Garaff y^e North Corner of m^rs Zachariah Maynards Barn 35. to a Stake 36. Ditto and so by to Maynards House & then turn the Right as the way now goes to a small Pine adjoining to m^rs David Maynards Land 37 to a Stake about twelve Rods from Pantrey Road then turns more Northerly with a Bowing line to a large Pine on y^e Westerly Side Pantrey Road the way Being two Rods wide Excepting at y^e Cross way By to Zach. Maynards And there from the fence to fence also at Pantrey Road there to extend from the Pine last mentioned to the White oak marked Near Pantrey Bridge there Being about twelve Rods wide further more a way through Part of m^rs David Maynards Land from a white oak at the southerly Corner of to Maynards Road to a pine and so to m^rs David Maynards Land Easterly from to Maynards house to Boundary marked the way is with Charge of Bying any Land
