

Sudbury October 4th 1743

At The Request of Thomas Dammun and others for a highway
 To Come to the Publick Worship & The Selectmen met & laid out
 a highway to accomodate them & Beginning at Natick Bound in
 Land of William Rice at a white oak tree marked standing
 By a Run of Water The way is laid out one Rod and a half wide
 on y^e west Side of D Tree & so on to a Poplar Tree Marked
 3rd a pine Tree Marked 4th a Birch marked 5th a white oak marked
 6th a white oak Marked 7th a white oak marked 8th a wild cherry
 Tree Marked By D. Dammun house y^e D marks are all on
 y^e East Side of D way 9th so on to an Apple tree marked
 Between D Dammun and Mr. Brintralls 10th a Rock at y^e
 Turn of D way y^e way is laid out on y^e west Side of y^e aforesaid
 marks and so on Between said Brintralls house By his house where y^e
 Cart Path Now Goes one Rod and a half wide to Snake Brook so also
 Between D Brintralls & Mr Henry Lookers & so on one Rod and a
 half wide on y^e fore side of D Lookers house then turned
 Northward as y^e Path Now Goes Between D Lookers house one
 Rod and a half wide till it comes to a valley ^{then} up passing ground
 one Rod & a half wide ^{on y^e South Side} of a Rock standing in D Lookers place
 on y^e Northerly Side of his field ^{on y^e South Side} going up passing ground on y^e South
 Side of a white oak tree marked so on in y^e Land of William Rice on y^e
 South Side of a walnut Tree Marked so on to a white oak tree marked
 on y^e North Side of said way so on down falling ground to William
 Rice fence said fence Being y^e North Bound of D way till it comes to a
 Stake & Stone in said fence hence going across or in D Rices pasture
 where the North formerly went to a white oak stump at Draw Bars y^e
 Highway is laid out one Rod and a half wide all y^e way in William
 Rices Land said white oak stump Being on y^e South Side of
 D way then y^e New way enters a highway laid out from or By
 William Rices to a place some time past Don^t Walter withes
 Memorandum The owners of y^e Land were all there at y^e Laying out
 said way and consented to give y^e Land Contained in said Highway without
 any Charge to y^e town of Sudbury
