 Strait Line through y^e Land In y^e Possession of Isaac Proad to
 To the South East Corner of y^e field formerly Belonging to
 Mathew Gibbs Deceased and so By y^e fence till it Comes to y^e
 Road upon Lanhams Plain. This said highway was laid out
 By a Committee of y^e Proprietors of y^e Common Lands In
 Sudbury on July 1715 as By y^e Said Records will fully appear

 of Mr. Elijah Haynes at a Road Leading from y^e West meeting house
 In Sudbury To Concord Running westerly Between the Lands of Mr. Joseph
 Voyce and Land In y^e Possession of y^e Wid^e Sarah Haynes on the
 Northerly Side of y^e Mr. Voyces Land and so on to a Black oak Stand
 ing By y^e Road Leading Down By the House of Mr. James Haynes
 Bounded as followeth Beginning at y^e Road Leading from
 Sudbury to Concord Bounded as the fence now Stand untill it
 Comes to a wallnut tree Standing In y^e wall then To a Stake
 By the wall To way is Two Rods wide from y^e Wallnut Tree &
 Stake then Bounded southerly & Northerly By the fence as it now
 Stand said way is about two Rods wide through out untill it
 Comes to the Black oak By y^e Road Leading Down By y^e
 Mr. James Haynes House
