

Sudbury May 17th 1739 we the Subscribers Selectmen of Sudbury have granted & allowed unto Mr Benjamin Barron of Concord and to his heirs and assigns for ever Fourteen Aers of Land in two several situate Lying & Being in the Sudbury afore said and on the westerly side of Sudbury River & is in the lands called the Easterly Thirty Rod Highway) as viz Ten acres & twenty five Rods Lying at the Norther End of the Thirty Rod way Bound Easterly By a Lot of Land Laid out to the Right of the widow Hunt Northerly Bounded By Sudbury and Concord line westerly Bounded By Land left for a highway to Three Rods Lying Between and the head of the new grant Lots & is Southerly Bounded By Land Claimed By Joseph Maynard Also Three acres & one hundred & thirty & five Rods Lying on the Northerly side of Cedar Swamp hill Bounded Northerly By a highway Leading from Thomas Smiths To the meeting house westerly Bounded By Land of the above said Joseph Maynard and is otherways Bounded By Common Lands and each Piece is further Bounded and Described as may appear By these Platts as it was Surveyed and Laid out By John Hayns Surveyor All which is in Consideration of & in full Satisfaction to the said Benjamin Barron for the Land which was taken from him by ^{for a highway} ~~and for a highway~~ The Selectmen of Sudbury Leading from Thomas Smiths To the meeting house Through a lot of Land Belonging to the said Barron when the said way was Laid out Lying and Being in Sudbury afore said and is in the Catalog and known By the Name of New Grants all which humbly Submitted to the said Town of Sudbury for their Acceptance and allowance Surveyed By
