

Dudbury December y^e 28 1750

The selectmen of D. Dudbury laid out a high way beginning at a Pair of Bars near the East End of the widow Drummons now Dwelling house from thence Running North Easterly as the Path is now trod & by a heap of Stones a little within y^e widow Drummons fence and Two Trees marked standing in the fence of y^e D. widow Drummons said matter is on the Easterly side of said way still as the way is now trod & by a stake & Stones & by a small Pine tree marked on the Easterly side of y^e way & on till it comes to the southerly End of Joshua wheelers field near y^e southeasterly corner of y^e field & Running southerly of said field till it comes to the southeasterly corner of said field then then Turning southerly across said way to a stake & Stones y^e southeasterly corner of said wheelers land & Running Easterly on the southerly bound of said wheelers land and southerly bound of y^e way till it comes to a Pine tree marked near said Bound then Turning northeasterly a cross said wheelers land to a small Oak marked & on near y^e said point to a white Oak tree marked a cross y^e way & Running Easterly then turning a stake & Stones standing on the southerly side y^e way in the line between m. Joshua wheeler & m. Jonathan Harmon and the said stake & Stones being the north westerly Bound of said way still Running near the D. point and bounded southerly on said Harmon fence till it comes to Land laid out by the selectmen of Concord for a high way by D. Harmons now Dwelling house like wise a slip or Goer of Land adjoining to Land laid out by the selectmen of Concord for the use of a high way & namely beginning at the last mentioned stake and Stones from thence Running northwesterly to a small Birch marked being on the Dick Bank at Concord line the D. piece of Land is bounded northerly on Concord D. Line southerly on the above D. high way south of said stake & Stones the D. high way to be one Rod & a halfe in width also a high way beginning at a point where Concord line leaves D. Jonathan Harmon south field & Running Easterly & adjoining to a slip of Land laid out by D. Concord selectmen for the use of a high way adjoins to the D. slip to make it one Rod & a halfe in width from thence Running with y^e Line between D. Harmon & Thomas Barney as far as they join & one halfe of y^e D. way on each side of said Line: & on as the way is now trod till it comes to a small Apple tree then Turning in to said Barneys field where the way formerly went a bout Eight or nine Rods then Turning out of said field in to the Road now trod & Running in the Road by the D. Barneys Dwelling house and so Running as the way is now trod threew Mr. Daniel Farrars farm to an old Trod way from Dudbury to Concord the above mentioned high way to be one Rod & a halfe in width Decepting by the D. Barneys Dwelling and there as the fences now stand
