These may Certifie to all Persons to whom these Presents shall come that the Boundaries hereafter named are the true Bounds between the Towns of Sudbury and Framingham agreed upon by Cap^t Henry Emmes & M^r George Walkup both of Framingham And M^r Isaac Gibbs and Elijah Smith both of Sudbury all of them Appointed by S^r Townes to perambulate & renew the Boundaries between the S^r Towns in Witness whereof we have hereunto set our hands. The Bounds are as followeth. viz^t Beginning at a white Oak Tree marked betwixt M^r Joseph Beals house & barn on the Easterly Side of the Road then running a straight line to a stake & Stones on the Easterly Side of the River on a point of Land from thence as the River runs to a stake & Stones on a Ditch bank on the West Side of Sudbury River: then running Westely to a stake & Stones on a stump on the top of a hill in the Land of M^r Isaac Read: from thence to a stake & Stones near a Road: from thence to a stake & Stones near a spring from thence to a stake & Stones near M^r Nathaniel Gibbs And from thence to a stake & Stones on a Ridge hill And from thence to a black birch near a Brook - And from thence to a white Oak in the fence between M^r Noah Eaton's And M^r Samuel Brown's - And from thence to a black Oak in the fence between M^r George Walkup & M^r Noah Eaton's - from thence to a white Oak in the fence between S^r Eaton's & M^r Hopstill Brown - And from thence to a white Oak in the fence of M^r Josiah Brown Esq^r - from thence to a stake & Stones near M^r Sam^l Burbanks Corner - from thence to a chestnut tree - And from thence to a black Birch - from thence to a white Ash tree - from thence to a black Oak tree - And from thence to a stake & Stones in the fence between M^r Jonathan Stankopes & M^r Ezekiel Hows - from thence to a black Birch in the fence of M^r Amos Parmenter - from thence
