Here is two Plans the one of thirteen acres and a halfe: And the other of one
 acre and 140 Rods which I have Laid out by order of the said Towns Committee
 unto Joseph Stanhope and Samuel Stanhope (and at their Desire) Each pease of Land
 is situate Lying and Being in Sudbury aforesaid - and is in the westerly
 Thirty Rod wide High way so called in the Lands called the New Grants
 and is Bounded: Each pease as it is set forth by the Plans
