 we who hereunto Subscribe, Select Men of sd Town have been & have
 Laid out a way for him the sd Asher Cutler in sd Sudbury, and on
 the Westerly Side of sd Sudbury River, and so laid out in some land
 formerly reserved by the proprietors of the Common Lands in sd Sudbury
 for a Way, to the meadows called allowance Meadows. &c and is and lyeth
 on the Southerly Side of sd Allowance Meadows, and is Northerly Bound
 ed by the sd allowance Meadow fence Now in the Possession of Joseph
 Reed, Jar Daniel Stone and the sd Asher Cutler, and to farther Bound
 ed the Northwesternly Corner of sd Way, being a Swamp White Oak
 Tree marked standing in an angle of the sd Joseph Reeds allowance
 Meadow fence and is the Northerly Corner of some lands belonging
 to the sd Asher Cutler and is Southwesterly Bounded two Rods, wide
 on his the sd Asher Cutlers Land, and from the sd Cutlers Land Eastward
 ly, running by and on the Southerly Side of sd Way about seven Rods to
 a white oak Tree marked, standing about one Rod and an half, but
 only from the aforesaid Allowance Meadow fence - And so on Easterly
 by marked Trees until it comes to a white Oak Tree marked only
 on the Northerly Side, standing about five Rods Westerly from the sd
 Asher Cutlers Meadow Bars: and from thence on Eastwardly to a stake
 and stone standing about one Rod East of the sd Ashers Meadows Bars
 above mentioned and is one Rod and an half Southerly of the above
 Named Joseph Reed, Hop Meadow fence Wm Baldwin
