

At a Meeting of the Select Men Nov: 22nd 1773 the Select Men laid out a High Way, two Rods wide, Beginning at a Stake and Stones about ten Rods south of Mr Samuel Goodenow's Dwelling House, and from thence running North, as the Path now is Rod to a small pine Tree marked and from thence a straight line North to another pine tree marked and so to Lancaster old Road, the Road is two Rods wide, and the marks are on the Side of said Road

At a Meeting of the Select Men Nov: 22nd 1773 The Select Men laid out a High Way, Beginning at a Stake and Stones at Lancaster old Road, at Mr Zephariah Maynard's Field Fence, with a Curve line to another Stake and Stones, and so to a pine tree marked, and so to another pine Tree marked, and so to a white Oak Tree marked, and so to a Stake and Stones, to the Widow Mary Brigham's Stone wall, and bounded Northerly as the fence now stands to Lieut Joseph Willis's Gate, the Road is two Rods wide and the marks on the East and North side of the way as the path is now Rod.
