A Gray mare of Joseph Moor's Branded with S on y nere Buttrick  
and a Gray horse Colt three year old Branded with S on y nere Buttrick  
and a black on his forehead of Joseph Moor's  
A Brown Colt a year old with a star in y forehead Branded with  
y Letter S on y nere Buttrick of Joseph Moor's May 2 1713

A Brown Horse of Thomas Moor with a blaze down y face and  
part at y nose and a little belt cut out of y near ear and branded  
with y Letter S on y nere Buttrick May 11 1713

A black mare Colt 2 year old of Nathans Griffins Branded  
with y Letter S on y nere Buttrick and a star on y forehead  
Entered May 6 1714

A brown Chestnut Culler mare Colt of Capt Joshua Haynes 2 year old  
Branded with y Letter S on y nere Buttrick and taken out off y ear  
A brown gray horse Colt 2 year old Branded with y Letter S on y  
near Buttrick of David Haynes 1714

A Blackish mare Colt Coming 3 year old with a brown nose and Brand  
with y Letter S on y nere Buttrick of Ben<sup>m</sup> pommerters Se 1715

A Brown Chestnut Culler horse with a star in y forehead and a white nose  
Branded with y Letter S on y nere Buttrick of Eleazer Tradanbays 1715

Sudbury June 26 1716 taken up by John Duntan a stray mare a dark brown  
or the stout Culler branded on the near buttrick with 111 a star in the forehead  
a little white on the nose and 2 saddle spots 111  
Sudbury July 6<sup>th</sup> 1716 Taken up By Peter Jenison of Sudbury in Damage  
feesent a bay mare Coming in four or five years old with one white foot  
and a star in the forehead
