proprietors to prosecute and punish or persons that have made
violation or intrusion upon the proprietors timber shall receive
of Mr Joseph Noyes town Treasurer so much of the proprietors money as
may prosecute such offenders to full Effect:
this above sd vote was past into an act at a Brown Moderator

Also the above sd day and year the proprietors ^{meeting} was a second from
June 10th to September the 9th at the ten of the Clock forenoon

Also the day and year above written the proprietors appointed a Community
to go and view the word of land that Deacon King desires to Exchange
with the proprietors in the great swamp the Community are

Deacon Noyes
S^r John Barnum
S^r Samuel King

At a proprietors held by Quorum the 28 of October 1703 then voted that
all the aforesaid undivided lands shall be layd out to each man their lots
According to his Rightfull interest. Those Names that past this vote are
as followeth Mr Edward Pollham: Mr Thomas Brown Mr Samuel Paris: Mr Joseph Noyes
John Smith: Thomas Spruce: James Josse: Hoxstill bout John Cook

Also the above said day and year a second vote at a meeting of the proprietors
held by Quorum the proprietors of Sudbury did then vote that all the
undivided lands of our town shall be layd out proportionally to every mans
Rightfull interest

from this vote dissented John Haynes

Joseph Stanhope
Benjamin Mow
