

Sudbury march 25 1709

at a meeting of the select men and minister of the town of Sudbury did by a vote agree to take but three pound of the widow Sarah Bonkers at probo of the Rent that is now due of others forty shillings to remain in the Bonkers hands till the minister and select men call for it

Sudbury June 19th 1718

Received of the select men of the town of Sudbury the sum of four pounds eighteen shillings in part for keeping Mehitable Gilborn & say received by us Administrators to John Gibbs Estate Deced

Sudbury September 29th 1718

Received of Abraham Wood two two pounds six shillings towards pay for keeping of Mehitable Gilbird & say received by me: Sarah ^{for} Gibbs
mark

Sudbury June the 22nd 1719 then received of the select men of the town of Sudbury five pounds & fifteen shillings in part of seven pounds & sixteen shillings which was due for keeping Mehitable Gilbird till the 25th of March 1719 we say received by us Sarah ^{for} Gibbs
mark

July the 3rd 1719 Then received of Abraham Wood by order of the select men one and forty shillings in full for keeping of Mehitable Gilbird the year 1718- which ended the 25th of March 1718/19: we say received by us Sarah ^{for} Gibbs
mark

Sudbury July the 11th 1720 Then received of the select men of Sudbury three pounds of money in part for keeping of Mehitable Gilbird in the year 1719: say received of me Nathaniel Gibbs for me and my Mother Sarah Gibbs =
