

In the City of London the 19th of February 1707 Whereas we the Subscribers are appointed
and Chosen by Mr James Shermans Attorneys and of Committee for the
Town of Sudbury to be a Committee to Consider and Judge of the worth of the
the said James Shermans hath for and upon the long lands &c which
was formerly granted by the Town of Sudbury to the said James Shermans
upon his settlement with them as may appear by the Contract or Statute
Record Borend date 30 of December 1648 now the Subscribers have
accordingly proceeded therein as followeth viz that whereas the said
James Shermans departed from the Town and Cared as to carrying on the
work of the ministry there had mutually Judge of all the premises formerly
granted by the Town to Mr Shermans to be returned to the Town according
to the Contract and also all the Buildings fencing orcharding &c thereon
or for the premises for which the Town of Sudbury are here by obliged to
pay or Cares to be paid unto the said James Shermans his Lawfull Attorney
heirs Executors Administrators or assigns the true and full sum of twenty
pounds money at 15 pence weight as it now ordinarily passeth between
man and man the money 45 pounds thereof to be paid as or before the first
day of May next ensuing which will be in the year of our Lord 1707 and of
other 45 pound to be paid as or before the first day of December next
following and upon the return of all the premises and payment of the money as
before shall be official of the matters between the said James Shermans
and the Town of Sudbury referring to the said premises
both payments of sum of money to be paid at the New dwelling house
of Mr Susanna Blanford in Sudbury above said
