 Know, you that whereas there hath been a Controversy between
 John Fitt and Thomas Frint both of Sudbury in the County of
 Middlesex about a line between ~~the~~ them against the land that
 formerly was Mr Williams browns and the land formerly belonging Mr Potter
 Noyes and now for a final Issue of all differences about said line we have
 agreed and Concluded that the line shall begin at a whit oak on the
 South East Corner and so a straight line to the brook to the ~~line~~ Fitt and
 twenty fods up the brook from the Fitt: and so then to continue on the
 Southwesterly side of the brook to the Fitt: To which agreement we have
 our selves our heirs Executors Administrators and assigns for ever:
 it is to be understood that the brook is the bounds two and twenty fods down
 to the Fitt: We have agreed both parties that this agreement should
 be Recorded in the town books
