to a white oak marked and next a pine and then coming  
into Zachariah Mainers grant & Then another pine marked  
By Then a black oak & next a black oak and next a pine y<sup>e</sup>  
said way to Exton: 2 Rod southerly of these marked trees  
Then coming to y<sup>e</sup> line betwixen Zach Mainers and y<sup>e</sup> grant y<sup>e</sup>  
was formerly Deacon John Hayness Running in Zach Mainers grant  
to y<sup>e</sup> Easterly side To y<sup>e</sup> 30 Rod high way y<sup>e</sup> way to be two Rod  
wide upon y<sup>e</sup> southerly side of Zach Mainers grant Joining to  
Northwesterly line of John Hayness grant then myd way of y<sup>e</sup> said  
to y<sup>e</sup> southerly side of y<sup>e</sup> grant y<sup>e</sup> way formerly Deacon John Hay
