Sudbury November 23 1705:

At a Town meeting legally warned y^e Town being assembled proceeded to y^e work of y^e day
1: Capt John Goodnow chosen Moderator
2ly: Voted y^e Town will chuse a man to preach y^e word of god unto us: for a quarter of a year
3ly Mr Loring chosen for y^e work of y^e ministry for y^e first year
4th Voted y^e 3 Deacons and m^{rs} Brown should be at wth Mr Loring to see if he will accept of y^e Towns choyce
