At a town meeting legally warned the town being at that time a place
proceeded to the work of the day: major Tho Brown chosen moderator

pay the money granted by the Town to m^r Loring for his preaching

At a town meeting legally warned: voted and agreed by y^e Town to

running the bounds of y^e Town of Sudbury and for William Brown
John Brigham for serving at y^e generl Court as Representatives
for y^e Town of Sudbury and m^r Samuel Parrish for being y^e Towns
School master three months and for ringing y^e bell and keeping
of y^e Towns meeting house and to William Gennison for a contrv Acte
of Janil Redd that he could not get and Sam^l King and Thomas
plympto for goeing to answer m^r Sharmers a turnmes in y^e behalf
of y^e Town of Sudbury for thier time and what money they
were out for y^e Town and to John Clapp for tending Cambridge
Court and for Richard more for taking of Copies out of Sudbury
Towns Booke to goe to Court all this was allowed by y^e Town
and that should be a rate made to pay y^e Towns debts that
were then brought in
