Mayor Tho Brown Chosen moderator for this meeting  
at Sudbury June y<sup>r</sup> 24<sup>th</sup> 1706 At a general town meeting  
of y<sup>r</sup> Inhabitants and proprietors of y<sup>r</sup> Town of y<sup>r</sup> Town of Sudbury  
being met at time and place legally warnd. Did then agree  
and vote that there should be a rate granted of twenty  
one pound in money to carry on y<sup>r</sup> the now depending between  
m<sup>r</sup> James Sharmen or his certain attornies and the Town of Sudbury  
and to be delivered to y<sup>r</sup> Constables to gather and collect  
and pay into the Towns Treasurers and in case there be agreement  
between y<sup>r</sup> above J<sup>r</sup> m<sup>r</sup> Sharmen or his attornies and y<sup>r</sup> Town  
of Sudbury before y<sup>r</sup> Court then y<sup>r</sup> money so be kept in the  
Treasurers hand till y<sup>r</sup> the Towns calls for it for some other  
use: and this above said 21 pound to be put into a rate by  
the select men: and be delivered to the Constables to be gathered  
forth with: -

James Bernard was Chosen to Tho Brown Moderator  
Joyned with y<sup>r</sup> former Committee to go to Court: and to act  
in that matter between y<sup>r</sup> Town and m<sup>r</sup> James Sharmen: which  
is now depending
