we y^e select men of Sudbury order you to warn y^e freholders and
others inhabitants off and belonging to y^e Town of Sudbury qualified as
y^e Law directs to meet at y^e meeting house on Tuesday y^e Twentieth
Second of October Current at Twelve of y^e Clock noon of sd day
there and there to do what is farther needfull at Settlement of
M^r Israel Loring who our present minister: Jonⁿ. Rice

Sudbury At a Town meeting Legally warned y^e inhabitants and proprietors
October 22 1706 being met at time and place proceeded to y^e work of y^e day mayor
The Browne Chosen moderator

at y^e same time the town did agree and vote to give to M^r
Israel Loring our present minister fifty pounds in money for y^e
Settle him self y^e said fifty pounds to be paid by y^e town of Sudbury to M^r
Israel Loring within three years after this date which will be in y^e year 1709
and y^e ~~town~~ is to provide M^r Israel Loring a ministerial
place for M^r Israel Loring line in so long as he y^e sd M^r Loring
shall be y^e minister of y^e Town of Sudbury and preach y^e word of God there
The intended for a ministerial place is y^e house and lands and meadows
that M^r James Sharnon formerly enjoyed with all y^e rights
James Sharnon had when he was y^e minister of y^e town of Sudbury

accept of what is offered for a settlement to me and do promise where
God shall call me to y^e office of a pastor among you according to my
ability to serve you therein

done nothing: nor will do nothing in a little time nor give security
to y^e above named Jonathan Rice Thomas Plimpton and John
Loker to show Content there are to secure what they can find
that Walter Shephards Estate and act according to their best
Judgment in y^e matter
