the money to y^e Attourneys according to y^e Town order and they
would not Receive it and so act in the Concern be shown m^r.
Sharmen or his Attourneys and the Town of Sudbury what shall
be further need full in that matter
and make Return of your doings to y^e Select
men at time and place

At a Town meeting legally warned John Brigham was
Chosen moderator and y^e Town having heard the Return
of y^e men they sent to m^r Sharmens Attourneys who offered
the sum of money to m^r Sharmens Attourneys according to y^e
Town order but said Attourneys Refusing said sum of money
now said Town the day and yeare above written voted y^e
they would Prosecute a Renew in y^e Case depending between
m^r Sharmen and the Town of Sudbury as to arrears of rates
This past into an act y^e day and yeare above written
