Sudbury february y^e 6 1707 to y^e Constable of Sudbury we the select men of
order you to warn y^e freeholders and other Inhabitents of and belonging
to the town of Sudbury qualified as y^e Law directs to meet at y^e meeting
House on Monday y^e tenth of february Instant at Twelve of y^e Clock of y^e day
y^e select men have Received a note from Mr Sharrmons Attornyes
wherein y^e Attornyes do send that they intend to goe upon y^e prefall
of y^e leons forble with y^e day perfixt is eleventh day of february Instant
But y^e select men have agreed with y^e Attornyes to stay till y^e eighteenth
day of february Instant and not no longer. y^e not being together to act
no y^e select men bring it to y^e town to act as they see cause in that matter
and to heere y^e Return of our Attornyes from y^e Last Superior Court and
take Care y^e Committee that have bene Implied by y^e order about making up a
Counts with Mr Sharrmons Attornyes may have Satisfaction for y^e time
they spent upon y^e towns a Count and y^e select men that have bene had to
prison upon y^e towns account and make your Return of your doings to y^e select men
