Raise money to pay y^e hundred pound for which y^e Select men
stand Bond and to se that forty five pound which is to be paid
By y^e first of may next to Mr Sharmon or his attorneyes as
to y^e Hous be granted and collected according to y^e above said
Act: and make your Return to y^e Select men at time and place
of your doing
By vertue of this within written order I have

fit as y^e Law Direct to meet at time and place

At a town meeting Legaly warned y^e town being at time and place
proceedd to y^e worke of y^e day John Rice Chosen moderator
and y^e town did there agree and vote to grant a money Rate of
seventy pound to make up what is left of y^e sixty and six pound
worth of old arrears of Mr Sharmons Rate which is twenty five pound
one hundred and forty five pound: forty five pound to be paid at or
before y^e first of may next which y^e first payment for y^e hous: and one
hundred is to be paid at or before y^e last Tuesday of July next this above
Rate is to be paid at fifteen penny weight in silver money and y^e Select
men are ordered to make y^e seventy pound Rate forth with and deliver it
to y^e Constables to gather and collect and pay into y^e town Treasurer
this above written vote past into an act by y^e town y^e day and
yeare above written John Rice moderator
Likewise it was voted that y^e Select men should give out warrants
to y^e Constables to fetch in Mr Sharmons old arrears that are yet
be hind
