

Sudbury June 2 1707 At Town Meeting Legally convened
The Town being met at time and place proceeded to y^e work
of y^e day May the Broune Chosen Moderator
The day and yeare above written noted on sd day that all such
persons as have Received with Mr Sharmons attorney and y^e
Committee of Town supplied have accompt of y^e same and sd
persons have paid their Rates and made y^e same appear so to be
and such persons as since y^e time have paid y^e Constable and so
ought to be clear upon y^e accompt afore sd their Rates now in
y^e hands of y^e select men shall be Crossed
Likewise such persons as forthwith shall pay their dues on
sd accompt of Rates shall be Crossed and such as refuse
or neglect to pay their dues upon y^e same accompt shall be
proceeded against in a Court of Law
on y^e day and yeare above sd noted that John Rice and John Balcorn
are Impowered to Cross y^e Rates according to y^e above named dues
and then they to deliver y^e Rates to Mr Loxon and David Haynes
to Collect what is behind
Voted on sd day y^e John Brigham and Sam^l King are Impowered
to pay y^e 100 pound y^e was Borrowed for y^e Town at Charlestown
Likewise y^e above sd John Brigham and Sam^l King are Impowered
if occasion be Borrow money to make up y^e 100 pound 103 pound and y^e Towns

Voted on sd day y^e y^e Town Treasurer is ordered by y^e Town to

Sudbury July 29 1707 To y^e Constable of Sudbury
One y^e select men of Sudbury order you to warn y^e freeholders
and other Inhabitants of and belonging to y^e Town of Sudbury
Qualified as y^e Law directs to meet at y^e meeting house on
Friday y^e eight of August next at twelve a Clock noon
of sd day to see what y^e Town will doe in order to prosecute
those persons who neglect and refuse to pay what is
there due to Mr Sharmons Attorneys as to Rates and to see
that Mr Israel Loring half yeare salary be granted
and to see that y^e forty five pound be granted where is
y^e last payment that belongs to y^e house that was
formerly in y^e possession of Mr Sharmons The Plimpton
By virtue of this order I have warned Select Men
of Inhabitants to meet at time and place men Mathew Stone
