At a town meeting legally warned John Brigham Chosen
the day and year first above written it was agreed and
concluded that there shall be a meet person or persons
Constables namely John Loker and David Haynes if so three
are fully Impowred in y^e name of y^e Town to prosecute
any person or persons what so ever in y^e Law that shall
neglect or Refuse to pay to them or either of them for y^e
what so ever shall appear to be there due upon y^e Rates
formerly made by y^e Towns order for Mr James Sharmou
John Brigham Chosen to act with Constables about
Mr Sharmou's old arrears: and y^e Town to find money to
pay on y^e Charge in y^e Law: This was past into a act y^e
day and year above written By y^e Town. John Brigham

At y^e a lne meeting Mr Strail serving half years salary
was granted
and Likewise by a vote of y^e Town a Rate of fifty five pound
was granted money five and forty pound to pay Mr Sharmou
or his Law ful attorneyes upon y^e account of y^e Towns belonng
to y^e Town of Past to goe towards y^e fifty pound due at Charles
if need be Ell to Remain for y^e Town use.
This was past into a act by a vote of y^e Town y^e day and
year above written.

Sudbury October 16 1704 To the Constable of Sudbury -
we y^e select men of Sudbury order you to warn y^e freeholders and other
Inhabitents of and belonng to y^e Town of Sudbury to meet and
assemble at y^e meeting House on Tuesday 21st of October instant at
one of y^e Clock of said day to see if y^e Town will doe any thing by way
of answer or objection as to y^e petition that is Lodged in the Generall
Court by some of our neighbors on y^e west side of y^e River for a
Presinct, we being Served with a Copy of y^e petition and y^e Contract
upon it and so take care that men be chose to pay y^e forty five pound
to Mr Sharmou or his attorneyes which will be due y^e first of Desember
next and also to take possession in y^e Towns behalfe of y^e premises
belonng to them and make Return of your doing hereunto the next
at time and place By order of y^e select men John Rice Clerk
By vertue of y^e within written order I have warned y^e freeholders and
other Inhabitents of y^e Town John Abbott Constable
