 Select men Town Clerk Constables and all other officers as of Law
 Directs and also take Care that Reverent pastor Mr Israel Loring
 may have his half yeare Salary paid him which is due y^e 15th of April
 next and to take Care of money be provided that was borrowed by those men
 that were Implied to pay of Hundred pound to Mr James Sharnon
 and make your Return to of Select men of your doing here in to of Select men
 at time and place By order of of Select men John Rice Town Clerk
 According to your order I have warned of freeholders and other Inhabitants
 to meet at of time and place John Balcom Constable

 to sweep our meeting House and Ring of bell for of year Indemnity
 and age of Cranes for which of town is to pay of said Beny
 Permenter forty Shilling
 At of above said meeting Voted y^t of Town of Sudbury Do fully
 Impower Mr Daniel Haynes to be of towns attorney to ask for and sue
 Lenny Recont and receive for of to town any or all such sum or sums
 of money as are in Mr Sharnons old debts and yet not paid or to a great
 with any such person as have not paid such debts said pardonor person
 paying said money to town so be at of Charge in of Law in and a Cent
 of Accounting of of same any money so recovered as above to be
 be paid into of Treasurer of Sudbury
