At a Town meeting Legally warned may 9th 1709 Capt John Goodenow Sr Ben Moore
Peter Haynes and Daniel Haynes Esq^r Jo^{seph} Permenter and Joseph Moore were appointed to bound
the bounds of y^e ministerial meadows in Sudbury with y^e parsons that sign to y^e
ministerial meadows or y^e major part of y^e above named parsons. Wednesday 18th
of May Instant is appointed to bound y^e bounds of y^e ministerial meadows and said parsons
are ordered to meet at y^e house of Daniel Haynes in Sudbury at Twelve o'clock of
said day to go upon y^e worke and make your return of your doing to y^e Town

At a Town meeting Legally warned may 9th 1709 upon y^e Complaint of Thomas Reed Sr
Concerning mechebel Gellbird who was in want. It was granted there should forty Shillings
be added to y^e Town Rate Last granted and to be delivered to y^e Town Treasurer and to be
paid to y^e above D^r Thomas Reed upon y^e account of mechebel Gellbird for y^e time past
and y^e above said Thomas Reed is ordered to take care of y^e said mechebel Gellbird
till further order from y^e Town

At a meeting of y^e Town of Sudbury Legally warned may 9th 1709 Voted by y^e Town
and granted unto Capt John Goodenow and Sam^l Wright eight pound ten Shillings money
on y^e account of y^e bell: and y^e above D^r Goodenow and Wright to give up their right
in y^e bell to y^e Town. This above written allowed by y^e Town may 9th 1709

At a Town meeting Legally warned may 9th 1709 Voted by y^e Town that no Ram
or Rams shall Ranie at Liberty on y^e Common or high way in Sudbury from y^e 1st of
August next untill y^e Last of October next after and in Case any person or persons
shall take up any Ram or Rams on y^e Common or high way in Sudbury y^e owner of
such Ram or Rams so taken shall pay two Shilling six pence to y^e person or persons
that shall take up D^r Ram or Rams and in Case any owner or owners shall neglect
or Refuse to pay y^e two Shilling and six pence as a fore D^r they having had six days
notis first by them that take up such Ram or Rams that then he or they shall
have y^e Ram or Rams so taken up for there payns and in Case y^e owner be not
known then he or they y^e have taken up any Ram or Rams shall set up a
notification at some public place of y^e Colter and marke in y^e Town of Sudbury
of such Ram or Rams and in Case no owner appeare within ten days after such
notification set up to pay y^e two Shillings six pence as a fore D^r then such
Ram or Rams ^{so taken} shall have them for there payns
