Town of Sudbury In y^e great and general Court to be holden at Boston
y^e 31st of this Instant may and so that y^e Town be provided with
a grammar school master and to see if there be a stock of ammunition
as y^e Law Directs Sudbury may y^e 17th 1710

Sudbury may y^e 19 1710 Matthew Stone chosen Deputee for y^e Town
of Sudbury for this ensuing year
at a town meeting legally warned may y^e 19 1710 J^{es} Noyes was
chosen grammar school master for y^e Town of Sudbury for y^e year
ensuing

Sudbury octo y^e 10 1710 at a town meeting legally warned y^e Town
being met at time and place it was then voted that y^e assessors shall
make m^r Israel Loring half year Rate of 5^s which began to grow
Dne y^e 5 of april 1710 and shall end y^e fifth of octo 1710

To y^e Constable of Sudbury we y^e Select men of Sudbury order you to warn y^e freholders
and other inhabitants of and belonging to y^e Town of Sudbury to meet at y^e meeting house
one Monday y^e fifth of march 1710/11 at nine of y^e Clock fore none then and there to chuse
Select men Town Clerk Constables tithing men and other Town officers as y^e Law directs
and to take care that paster m^r Israel Loring have his half year Salary paid him which
began to grow one y^e first of octo 1710 and shall end y^e fifth of april 1710/11 and to see
that y^e Town be provided with a grammar school master as y^e Law Directs and to see if y^e Town
will petition to y^e General Court to make our Long Caraway a County Road and so if
y^e Town will give m^r Israel Loring any answer to his petition he put in to y^e Town
y^e last Town meeting concerning y^e six acres of Land one y^e Common by Smith field
and to see if y^e Town will grant any money for y^e Relief of y^e poor
and make your Return to y^e Select of your Sudbury febr^y 19 1710/11 John Rice Town Clerk
