and vote that the assessors should make the great Long half year rate of 35 which began to grow due
first of october 1710 and is all due by fifth of april 1710/11 and tender it to the Constables gather and collect
and pay into the Treasurer

at a town meeting Legally ward march 5 1710/11 of Inhabitants being made at time and place
did then agree and vote to petition General Court to if one long case way might be made a County
road

at a town meeting Legally ward march 5 1710/11 of Inhabitants of the Town of Sudbury
being made at time and place did then Chose Dea Joseph Noyes to be of Towns
grammar School master for the year ensuing

At a meeting of Select men march 5th 1710/11 of Town Clerk was sworn
before of Select and then the Select men did by a vote order of Town Clerk
to give of oath unto the Select men of Town officers to whom an oath belongs
march 12 1710/11 of persons hereafter named were sworn by the Town Clerk
