This is to order you to wrd y^e freeholders and other Inhabitants of and belonging to the Town of Indbury Qualified as y^e Law Directs to meet at y^e meeting house on Friday y^e 18 of this Instant May at 12 of y^e Clock noon of sd day to Chose upon persons to serve and Represent y^e Town of Indbury in y^e great and general Court to be holden at Boston y^e Last Wednesday of May Instant and to see what way y^e Town will go in to maintain y^e High ways in Indbury and Towne Treasurer to give account to y^e Town at sd meeting and see if y^e Town will send in a petition to y^e general Concerning our Long Canisay By orders of y^e Select men John Rice Clerk

At a Town meeting May y^e 18 1711 Mathew Stone was Chosen Representative for y^e Town of Indbury

At y^e above said meeting Sam^l Wright was Chosen to Joyn with y^e Deputie to put y^e petition into General Court Concerning our Long Canisay

At a Town meeting Legaly wrd May y^e 30 1711 y^e Town being met at time and place Did then vote that they w^{ld} have a grammar School master as y^e Law Directs

At a Town meeting May y^e 30th 1711 Dac Jams Hayns and John Balcom w^{re} Chosen to take an Injoyce of y^e Inhabitants of y^e west Side of y^e River In August next and John Rice and Ephraim Pitts w^{re} Chosen to take an Injoyce of y^e Inhabitants one y^e East Side of y^e River at y^e time a year when by Law it should be taken

At a Town meeting May y^e 30th 1711 Capt Brown and John Rice w^{re} Chosen and appointed to goe ^{and} ap^{ro}ve a grammar School master for y^e Town of Indbury
