

Sudbury June 20th 1711 To y^e Constable of Sudbury Greeting
This is to order you to warn y^e freholders and other Inhabitants of and belonging to y^e
Town of Sudbury qualified as y^e Law Directs to meet at y^e meeting House on Friday y^e
29th day of June Corrant at two of y^e Clock after noon to see and take care that y^e Town
of Sudbury be forthwith provided with a grammar School Master as y^e Law Directs and to
grant money to pay y^e five pound for not having a School master and to grant so
much money as may be needfull for to Repare our meeting House where it wants and
to take care of Samuel Freeman and see if y^e Town will grant y^e money that is --
Disbursed for y^e Reliefe of y^e poor since y^e Town Rate was granted
and hereof fail not to make your Return to y^e Select: By order of y^e John Ree
at said time and place or Town Clerk Select men Town Clerk

At a town meeting legally warn'd June y^e 29th 1711 Lem^t Thomas Frank and Lem^t master
Thomas Brimnal were by a vote of y^e Town ^{was} chosen and appointed and fully Impowred
to get and agree with some Person who is well instructed in y^e Tongue to keep a School
in y^e Town of Sudbury for one year: not Exceeding y^e Sum of thirty pounds which Sum
of money so agreed upon to be paid by y^e Inhabitants of and belonging to y^e Town of
Sudbury to said School master for y^e years Service.

At a town meeting legally warn'd June y^e 29th 1711: y^e five pound was granted to pay
the fine for not having a school master as y^e Law Directs and also four pound
was granted to mend y^e our meeting House where it wants and y^e money
that is Disbursed for y^e Reliefe of y^e poor since y^e Last Town Rate was
granted: was allowed: and at said meeting y^e assessors were ordered forthwith to make
the Rate to pay y^e above said Sums of money and Deliver it to y^e Constables
to gather and Collect and into y^e Treasurers
and at y^e above said meeting Sam^l Freeman was ord^d to be one of y^e poor of
the Town of Sudbury.

Nov^r: y^e 5: 1711 To y^e Constable of Sudbury: This is to order you to warn y^e freholders
and other Inhabitants of and belonging to y^e Town of Sudbury qualified as y^e Law
Directs to meet at y^e meeting House on Thursday y^e 15th of Nov^r: Corrant at 12
a Clock noon of said day to see that our Rancrant pastor m^r Israel Loring have
his half year Salary paid him which be gone to grow due y^e fifth of April 1711 and
all due y^e first of October 1711 and to y^e Town of Sudbury be provided with
such Schools as will answer y^e Law and to here y^e Return of y^e Last Commet
who were Implied by y^e Town to get a School master for y^e Town of Sudbury
and to see if y^e Town will do any thing for y^e Reliefe of y^e poor Edm^d Ree

At a town meeting November y^e 15th 1711 y^e assessors by a vote of y^e Town ord^d
to make m^r Israel Loring of thirty five pound and Deliver it to y^e Constables to
gather and pay into y^e Town Treasurers

At a town meeting Nov^r: y^e 15th 1711 En^r: John Hayes and m^r Hopstel Bent
were chosen and appointed to treat with m^r Sam^l Parish to see if he would keep
School for y^e Town of Sudbury for a quarter of a year.
