At a town meeting y^e 17. 1711 the town voted to have bnt on School House and y^e School House by a vote of y^e Town to be at y^e gravel pit. y^e School House to be 20 foot long 16 foot wide six foot stand nine foot and a half spard y^e Sals to be white oak y^e out Sides to be boarded and y^e boards to be feather adge y^e In Side to brick and boarded with Riffe boards and a lower and upper flower to be Lead and a chimney and two glass windows 18 Enches square pet widows and y^e Riffe to be boarded and stungled At y^e above sd meeting y^e Town side agree with Joseph Permenter to build y^e School House and furnish it full to keep School in by y^e last of may. 1712 and y^e said Joseph Permenter is to have fourteen pound money paid him by y^e Inhabitants of and belonging to y^e Town of Endbury when said School House is completed according to agreement
