

Indbury May 13 1712: at a meeting of y^e Inhabitants of Indbury
Benj: Permenter Sr was Chosen and appointed to keep y^e meeting and
Ring y^e Bell for y^e year ensuing

At a town meeting May 13 1712 it was then voted that y^e Inhabitants
of and belonging to y^e Town of Indbury will allow openen^y p^e head
for all Black Cows and Jays that are sold by any of y^e Inhabitants of
and belonging to y^e Town of Indbury y^e year ensuing they bringing
y^e heads to y^e Select men or Constables of Indbury

At a town meeting legally warned May 13 1712 Mr Mather Stone
was Chosen Deputie for y^e Town of Indbury for y^e year ensuing

To y^e Constable of Indbury Greeting This is to order you to warn
the freeholders and other Inhabitants of and belonging to y^e Town
of Indbury qualified as y^e Law Directs to meet at y^e meeting House
on Friday y^e fifth of September 1712 at one of y^e Clock afternoon
of said day soe that Mr Wryan Clinger the School master has
a place provided for keep School in and to grant said School master
his half year salary and to see that Mr Israel Lormys half year
salary be paid him and to Chose a Committee to Renew y^e Bonds between
the ministerial meadows and y^e Inhabitants that have meadow joining
to y^e ministerial meadows and fully Impower said Committee to ~~Renew~~
act in y^e Towns behalf in Renewing and Statmg y^e Bonds of said
meadows and to there y^e Innoyce that y^e Inhabitants of y^e Town
of Indbury gave in to y^e assessors in August 1712 John Rree

At a town meeting September y^e fifth 1712

It was then agreed and voted that our present School master Mr
Wryan Clinger is to keep School y^e Rest of y^e quarter of y^e year
which be gone in July last 1712 and Ends in October next on y^e East
Side of y^e River in y^e South East quarter of Town of Indbury
they finding said School master a place to keep School in at there own
Charge

At a town meeting September y^e fifth 1712 y^e Inhabitants of y^e
Town of Indbury then ~~met~~ made do by vote Chose a Committee to
Renew y^e Bonds between y^e ministerial meadows and y^e Inhabitants
of Indbury that have meadow adjoining to y^e ministerial meadows
and said Committee is fully Impowered by y^e Town to Renew and Statmg
Bonds between y^e ministerial meadows and y^e Inhabitants that have
meadow joining to y^e ministerial meadows: y^e persons being timely notified
to meet at time and place to Renew bonds
