Inasmuch as you are Required warrd of freholders and
other Inhabitants of and belonging to the Town of Indbury on the
West Side of the River Indbury as the Law Directs to meet at the
meeting House on Sunday the 20th Day of this February Current at
Twelve of the Clock upon of said Day there being Complaint made
By Generall of the Inhabitants ^{was the} of the Remote ness
from and Difficulty in attending of publick worship of God as if
meeting House were standeth for remedy in said case we order
this meeting to be if of Town well for any thing to bring of
meeting House into of Center of of Town or within a quarter
of a mile of of Center or as near of Center as may be Conveniently
The Town of Indbury being seven miles long and if meeting
House as now standeth being but about a mile and a half from
the East End of said Town and to do any thing further of Town
shall be Caus in said affair
