At a town meeting april of 6 1713 y^e Town being met at time and place
Sary David Mayes Chosen moderator Joseph Moore was by a vote of y^e Town
allowed and granted for warning y^e Town meeting in y^e year 1712
Seventeen Shillings and Six pence
at y^e same meeting John Goddards Constable was by a vote of y^e Town
allowed and granted for warning of three Town meetings Twelve Shilling

At a town meeting Legaly warn april of 6 1713 Mr Peter Mayes
and Sary David Mayes were Chosen and appointed and fully im-
powered to goe and provide a person who is well instructed in y^e Law
to keep School in y^e Town of Sudbury for a quarter of a year
the Rate of thirty pound a year and no more and make Return of y^e same
Doing at next Town meeting David Gaynes moderator

At a town meeting april of 6 1713 the Town did take y^e pound
into their hands to mend and maintain at y^e Towns Charge
and y^e select men were ordered to be y^e pound put in good Repair
and y^e Charge of Repairing to be added to y^e Town Rate that next
to be made
