

Indbury March 29 1714 At a Town meeting of the Inhabitants of Indbury
granted to Mr Joshua Parker of Dorset School master for his keeping school
for the Town of Indbury sixteen pound for half year past

All said meeting of other Town tabs were brought in and allowed by the
Town and voted by the Town at said meeting that the assessors should
put all the Town tabs and Mr Lornys half year salary into one Rate
and at said meeting Josiah Willis Thomas Cutler Jonathan Gullyn
Benjamin Ree ward Chosen to Inspect Town for the year Indbury
and sworn and Tames permenters and John Grant were Chosen
highways or road surveyors and sworn before the select men

At the above meeting Benj permenter S^r Chosen and appointed to
swap our meeting house and Ring of Bell for the Indbury year

To the Constable of Indbury Greeting this is to order you to warn the
freeholders and others Inhabitants of and belonging to Indbury
Qualified as the Law directs to meet at the meeting on Monday the 17th
Day of May next at twelve of the Clock noon of the day then and there
to Chuse or Depute on or more able persons to serve and Represent them
in the Great and Genarall Court or assembly to be held on Wednesday the 26th
of May next ensuing at Gate hereof and make your order of your order
to the select men at time and place Indbury the 6 1714

According to this within written order I Sam^l Wright
I have warned the freeholders of Indbury David Hayes
to meet at time and place according John Rice
the Custom of the Town Indbury may 1714

At a town meeting May the 17 1714 Capt Hop^r Browne was
Chosen Representative for the Town of Indbury

July the 3 1714 the select men of Indbury were summoned by the Constable
of Indbury by warrant from the Clerk of the Court of Quarter Sessions
bearing date July the 1st 1714 to appear at Cambridge to answer to a plea freeman
At a meeting of the select men of Indbury July the 5th 1714 Lrd David
Haynes Mr John Clap and Mr Rice were Chosen and appointed
by the select men to go to Court of Quarter Sessions to be holden
at Cambridge by an adjournment on July the 8th 1714 to make answer
to what might be said concerning a plea freeman

The Court of Quarter Sessions being adjourned from July the 8th to July the 13th
At a meeting of the select men of Indbury July the 9th 1714 Lrd David
Haynes Clerk Sam^l Wright were Chosen and appointed to go to
the Court of Quarter Sessions to be held at Cambridge July the 13th 1714
to make answer to what might be said concerning a plea freeman
