

Indbury October 26 1714

At a town meeting of the Inhabitants of Indbury by
order of the Town Ephraim Curtis Noah Clapp William Jefferson
and Heptell Bent Chosen and appointed and fully impowered
them or any part of them to go to the generall Court on
Wednesday the 27 of October Current to answer to a petition
that some of the Inhabitants on the west side of the River have presented
to the generall Court for to be a town ship on the west side of Indbury
River

To the Constable of Indbury Greeting November 9 1714
These are to order you to warn the freeholders and other
Inhabitants of and belonging to the Town of Indbury Inalified
as the Law Directs to meet at the meeting house on Thursday the
Eighteenth day of November Current at Twelve of the Clock noon
of said day to hear the Result of the great and generall Court
Referring to a petition and a meeting house on the west side of
Indbury River and to Consider and Debate upon the severall
articles therein set forth and for an agreement of both parts
of the Town according to the Directions therein said and to see
there be a bridge built over Elizabeth River and make your
return to the select men at time and place

Indbury November 18 1714
