This is to order y^e Town of freeholders of and belonging to y^e Town of Sudbury to meet at y^e meeting House Tuesday y^e 2^d of Sept^r at Twelve o'Clock to see y^e Town will provide a school master as y^e Law Directs and provide a place or places to keep School in and to see y^e Town will grant money to provide ammunition for y^e Town and to see what answer y^e Town will give Joseph Perment^r concerning y^e School House he was to build for y^e Town and to see that our meeting house be mended when it wants and will also on or moore persons to y^e Com^{ty} that y^e Town have all ready chosen to prosecute for y^e ammunition that is stolen away and to y^e y^e Town will joyn with y^e proprietors of y^e River meads in y^e Sudbury to petition y^e Generall Court for y^e Removance of obstructions in y^e River which runs through Sudbury y^e proprietors to be at all y^e y^e Charge of y^e same.

Joshua Parker from being school master for y^e Town of Sudbury

Sudbury legally warned, voted y^e y^e Town of Sudbury joyn
with y^e proprietors of y^e River meads in Sudbury to petition
y^e generall Court for y^e Removance of obstructions in y^e River
that Damages y^e River meadows at y^e y^e proprietors Charge
at said meeting Capt Joshua Starns and Mr David Haynes
were chosen to make and prefer a petition to y^e generall
Court that y^e obstructions in y^e River y^e Damages y^e River
in Sudbury may be removed

Sept^r y^e 6 1715 at a town meeting y^e y^e Sudbury voted there should
be a Com^{ty} to treat with a school master of y^e Law Directs and
make return of there doing in y^e to y^e Town at there next meeting
the Town chose Mr James Barneby and Mr Sam^l Wright there Com^{ty}
to treat with a school master of Town at y^e above said meeting
Town voted to give Joseph Perment^r eight pound for y^e school
House he built as it is now done and said Joseph Perment^r
accepted of y^e same in full for it.

at y^e meeting of Town by a vote granted oriently five pound to
be levied on y^e Inhabitants of y^e Town of Sudbury to account and
buy ammunition for y^e Town of Sudbury by y^e Law Directs but when
ever y^e Town of Sudbury shall be divided or made two Towns y^e not
said Inhabitants shall have there the proportion according to
there rate. The Town voted y^e select men should see that y^e meeting house
be mended when it wants at y^e Towns Charge y^e Town by a vote
chose Mr James Barneby and added him to y^e Com^{ty} of Town chose to
prosecute the persons that have stolen of Towns ammunition.
