This is to order you to warn y^e free holders and other inhabitants of and belonging to Sudbury Qualified as y^e Law Directs to meet at y^e Meeting House in Sudbury on Monday y^e 14th of May next in y^e forenoon at Twelve of y^e Clock at Noon on said day Then and there to Elect and Depute one or more Parson or Parsons Being free holders and Residents in y^e Towne of Sudbury to serve for and Represente them in a Court and General Court to be Convened here and kept for his majesties service at y^e Town house in Boston on Wednesday y^e 30th of May next in y^e forenoon at Twelve of y^e Clock and to see if y^e Towne will Repair y^e house that y^e Widow Brooks lived in and you are to make Returne of your Doings Here in to y^e Select men at some and Place

Sudbury May y^e 14th 1716 This may Certify Home it may concerne that I have warned and ordered y^e Towne to meet at Time and Place according to y^e Custom of y^e Towne

Sudbury August y^e 2 1716 To the Constable of Sudbury Greeting
This is to order you to warn the free holders and other inhabitants of and belonging to Sudbury Qualified as the Law Directs to meet at y^e Meeting house on Tuesday the 14th of August Current at Twelve of y^e Clock at Noon on said day then and there to see if y^e Towne will Grant m^r Israel Loomings halfe years salary and to see if the Towne will Grant an addition to his salary or Give him a gratuity: and to see if the Towne will provide a grammar School master as y^e Law Directs and to see if y^e Towne will Grant Money to pay for m^r Josiah Jagueish is keeping school and to see if y^e Towne will Receive y^e ten pounds of these powder Comitty according to there former vote or to Act any thing further in said affair as they shall see Cause and to see if y^e Towne will Repair y^e house that y^e Widow Brooks lived in and m^r William Jenison Town breasurers is to make up his accounts at said meeting and make Returne of your Doings here in at time and place

Sudbury August 14 1716 Pursuant to this within written order I have warned y^e free holders and other inhabitants belonging to said Sudbury to meet at said time and place within mentioned according to y^e Custom of y^e Towne

At a town meeting legally warned in Sudbury August y^e 14 1716 y^e Town of Sudbury being met proceeded to y^e work of y^e day Chose m^r John Balcom moderator to bring on y^e work of the day at said meeting August y^e 14 the Town Granted m^r Israel Loomings halfe years salary at said meeting August y^e 14 1716 the Town Voted that they would have a grammar School master by vote the Towne Chose m^r Joshua Barker to be their School Master for four months after the rate of five pounds a Quarter he to begin teaching School this August 14 1716

August y^e 14 1716 the Town Granted 7-10-0 for Josiah Jagueish keeping school Lt Haynes his master to Receive the money and fully to Discharge the Town of any Demand for said Jagueish his keeping School in Sudbury this seven pound ten Granted for Jagueish his keeping school to be added to m^r Loomings Rate the assess was ordered by the Town to make m^r Loomings halfe years salary Voted by the Town that the house the Widow Brooks lived in shall be Repaired at the Towns Charge the Select men to order a man or men to do the work October y^e 7 1716 the assessers Made the Rate for m^r Loomings halfe years salary and for Jagueish his keeping School y^e Rate being 42-10-00 to tall
