of & belonging to the town of Sudbury Qualified as the
Law Directs to met at the meeting house in Sudbury on Wednesday
the twentieth Day of May Current at one of the Clock in the afternoon
on said Day to chuse & Depute one or more persons to serve for &
Repre sent them in the Grease & Generall Court or assembly appointed
to be convened hold & kept at the town house in Boston upon Wednesday
the 27th Day of May Next in seeing the Date here of Like wise to do
if the town wil Give Leave to the owners of the Lower Meadow Lots
to shot Up the high way from Mrs Blandfords Corner to the Upside
of Edward Grouts Meadow During the towns pleasure
fail Not to make Returne of your Doings here in to the Select
Men of Sudbury at time and place above Named
