

X Sudbury March the 22: 1719. 20 To the Constable of Sudbury Greeting
These are to order you to warn the freeholders & other inhabitants of & belonging to the
town of Sudbury Qualified as the Law Directs to Meet at the meeting house in Sudbury on
Monday the fourth Day of April next in the evening the Date hereof at twelve of the Clock at Noon
on said Day then & there to Give order to the Assessors to make the Reverend Mr Israel Loring's -
Half year Rate that is now become due Like wise to & if the town will Raise Mr Israel Loring's
Salary - All so to bring in Debt & Credit at the above said time & place - - Like wise to & if
the town will Allow the money the Select men laid out for the Relief of Ellick Candor Grant
in the time of his sickness: Like wise to employ a man to sweep the meeting house & Ring the
Bell & Dig Graves the year in the evening - - the town Agents that was employed to sue Lieut Colonel
Edmond Goffe of Cambridge for the towns Legacy are to Give a Court to said town of
their proceedings in that affair: All so to & if the town will employ them further in that affair
or Dismiss them or Either of them & employ others in their room to Manage in that affair
fail not to make Return of your Doings here in to the Select Men at time & place above Named

By Vertue of this order I have warned the inhabitants of the town of Sudbury to
Meet according to time and place with in mentioned according to the Custom of the town
April the 4th 1720 - - - - - Jonathan Griffyn Constable

The town being then Legally Meet to Review Debt & Credit & other Business the town
proceeded to the work of the Day & Chas. Esq. John Balcom Moderator to bring forward the work
of the Day at said meetings - - At said meeting the town by a vote ordered the Assessors to make
the Reverend Mr Israel Loring's Rate forth with -
At said meeting by a vote the town Dismissed Mr William Jonison & Mr Phenias Rice
the towns Agents that was empowered to sue Mr Edmond Goffe of Cambridge for a legacy
of fifty pounds Given the town of Sudbury by Mr Edmond Brown their former pastor
and the town voted that they would employ 3 men for their Agents to manage in that affair
and the town at the above said meeting proceeded to a new Choice & Chose for their
Agents to sue Mr Edmond Goffe of Cambridge for a Legacy of fifty pounds
Given the town of Sudbury by Mr Edmond Brown their former pastor & engaged
by Mr Edmond Goffe of Cambridge - - Mr John Rice & Mr Hopstill Bent &
Ephraim Curtis and fullye Authorized & empowered them or the Major part of them
to act & manage in that affair with the same power as the town gave to
their Agents Mr William Jonison & Mr Phenias Rice At a town meeting in
Sudbury Julye the 21st 1719

at said meeting April ye 4th 1720: the Town by a vote chose Mr Benjamin Larnmonte
To sweep the Meeting house & Ring the Bell & Dig Graves for the year in the evening
as he did the Last year
