

X Sudbury April 25th 1720 To the Constable of Sudbury Greeting,
These are to order you to warn the freeholders & other inhabitants of & belonging to the
town of Sudbury Qualified as the Law Directs to meet at the meeting house in Sudbury on
thurs^{day} the twelfth Day of May Next in the evening the Date hereof at twelve of the Clock
at Noon on said Day then & there to Elect & Depute one or more persons being freeholders and
Resident in the same town according to the Number set & Limited by an act of the Generall
Assembly to serve for & Represent them in a Great & Generall Court or Assembly appointed to be
Convened held & kept for his Majesties service at the Court house in Boston Upon Wednesday the
twenty fifth Day of May Next in the evening the Date hereof &c - - -
Likewise to be if the town will Raise the downe Mr Israel Larins Salary - - -
Or to be whether the town will Give the Ruer Mr Israel a Gratuity - - -
Likewise to provide a Grammar School matter for the town as the Law Directs - - -
Likewise to be if the town will build a meeting house & build the Long Casway & other
Casways as is set forth in the following petition viz: of sundry of the Inhabitants
of the town of Sudbury wee have hereunto subscribe Inhabitants of said Sudbury
that although the Act of the General Court Ordering that a meeting house be
Erected for the publick worship of god on the west side of said Sudbury kiner
implying two separate Congregations in said Sudbury yet we are humbly of opinion that
if the town can agree upon other Methods more conducing to their own peace &
welfare it will be very satisfactory to the honorable Court therefore we the subscribers
inhabitants of said Sudbury Do Request of you Gentlemen Select men of said Sudbury
that you would forth with Call the town of Sudbury to Gather by a warrant according
to the Custom of said town to meet at the Meeting house in said Sudbury - - -
To be if said town when met by a vote of said town will Remain one town in tier
and have but one meeting house in said Sudbury for the publick worship of god
in said Town of Sudbury & build a meeting house Long enough for the whole town above
said to meet in in sum short time as soon as may be done with conveniency and place
said meeting house on the west side of said Sudbury kiner at or near the Granil pit
at the westerly End of the Long Casway in said Sudbury in the most convenient
place & with all to be if said town will vote that the said Long Casway be amended at the
Charge of the said town of Sudbury for convenient passing by raising said Casway a
foot or a foot & a halfe higher than the highest place as they shall think most
convenient when met & also with all to mend the way from ^{said Granil pit as far as} for later Symptons
that is to be equal in height to the fore said Long Casway when mended as before
Expressed & all the Dirty way to be mended and made good passing as may be thought
Need full this said Casway to be mended at the Charge of said town of Sudbury in the
same way that the said Long Casway shall be made & made return - - -
