 These are to order you to warn the freeholders & other inhabitants of and belonging
 to the town of Sudbury Qualified as the Law Directs to meet at the meeting House in
 Sudbury on Monday the twenty ninth Day of August Current at three of the Clock
 in the afternoon on said Day then & there To supply a man or men to provide a
 Minister at present to preach whilst Mr. Loring our Reverend pastor is absent
 Like wise to Grant money to pay a Minister for preaching to the town till further order
 Likewise to order the Assessors to add what money the Town has Law to Grant
 into the Rate that is now to be made for our Reverend Pastor Mr. Israel Loring
 And make Return of your Doings here in to the Selectmen at time & place within mentioned

 of the Day & chose Mr. Peter Haynes Moderator to bring forward the
 work of the Day at said meeting

At said meeting the Town by a Vote Chose the Deacons to provide
 a minister at present till further order

Like wise the town by a Vote Granted ten pounds in money to
 pay a minister if there is a Case for so much for that year & for
 boarding of him and if there is not occasion for all the money for
 that year then the Remainder of the money to remain in the
 town Treasurers hand till further order

the town by a Vote ordered the assessors to add the ten pounds
 to the Rate now to be made for our Reverend Pastor Mr. Loring
