These are to order you to warn if freetholders and other inhabitants
of and belonging to the town of Sudbury qualified as the law directs
to meet at the meeting house in Sudbury on Thursday the 25 Day
of May Current at one of the clock after noon then and their
to Elect and Depute one or more person being freetholders and
Resident in if same town according to if Number set and limited
by an act of the General assembly to serve for and represent them
in a ~~General~~ Great or General Court or assembly appointed to be
Convened hold and kept for his majesties services at the Court
house in Boston on May if 31: Current: and so if the town will hear
the Return of the Committee Chosen by the town to make inquiry
after the Circumstances of the widow Cutler: and to so if the town
will do any thing further in that affair
and make Return of your Doing herein to the select men all so time
and place:
