Complaint being this Day made unto me of subscribers one of his majestyes Justices of y^e peace within and for y^e County of Middlesex by Benjamin parmenter Jon^r: and Eighteen other Inhabitants of y^e Sudbury setting forth that whereas y^e Grate and General Court at their sessions at Cambridge June: 9: last past ordered that there be a New meeting house Erected built and finished upon y^e place assigned by a Committee of y^e Court in December: 1715: and that y^e old meeting house be putt into Good Repair at y^e Charge of y^e whol Town: and that in order thereto Eleven of y^e Qualified Inhabitants of y^e Sudbury upon y^e 30 Day of October last past Express their Desire and Request in writing to y^e select men of Sudbury to order a Town meeting on that affair which they supposed wery Woodfull futable and Seasonable for providing of Timber and other materials for that work: and that y^e said select men upon y^e 30 Day of October last past Did Refuse or unreasonable Deney y^e Request as to me appears: And therefore humbly pray that a warrant may be Granted according to Law of y^e province for calling of a Town meeting: Viz to see if y^e Town will build and finish a New meeting house on y^e west side of River and also Repair y^e old meeting house on y^e East side: Likewise to see if y^e Town will vote the bignesse of y^e meeting house and to see in what way y^e Town will Carrey on that affair according to y^e order of the
